Chang Chun is a Salt Lake original owned by the Chhour family since 1988. The Chhour family came to Utah in the early 1980's as Cambodian refugees, then worked for the next several years to build their own businesses. Chang Chun's Chinese fare was formerly offered at the ZCMI Center Food Court, then "Food Court Jr.", a temporary location on the first floor of Eagle Gate Plaza set up during City Creek Food Court construction. Chang Chun offers a variety of Chinese fare, up to 20 different dishes daily.
